SUBJECT: USDA's Management of Password Security – Final Report

The Office of Inspector General (OIG) performed an inspection of two U.S. Department of Agriculture (USDA) offices to assess USDA's management of password security. OIG's objective was to determine whether USDA's password management practices effectively prevented the use of passwords that are commonly used, expected, or compromised. We analyzed the results of the password hash-cracking tests on USDA's Enterprise Active Directory accounts. We interviewed agency officials and reviewed and evaluated applicable laws, policies, and procedures related to USDA's password security management as of September 2024. This report contains sensitive content. It is being withheld from public release due to concerns about risk of circumvention of law.
