



USDA COVID-19 Funding Dashboard

The U.S. Department of Agriculture (USDA) Coronavirus Disease 2019 (COVID-19) Funding Dashboard allows stakeholders to explore an overview of the sources and uses of USDA’s COVID-19 funding. This interactive dashboard displays the amounts of USDA COVID-19 funding enacted, budgeted, obligated, and spent, by appropriations act, agency, program area, and use of funds, as identified by USDA’s Office of Budget and Program Analysis and by the Forest Service.

The COVID-19 Funding Dashboard allows users to see how much of the funding has been obligated; search for funding under particular appropriations acts or agencies or program areas; or explore how much of the funding has been, or remains to be, spent. The unaudited data include the amounts budgeted where the appropriations acts specified only “such sums as may be necessary.”



Funding for the U.S. Department of Agriculture (USDA) pandemic response comes primarily from five related appropriations acts:
• Families First Coronavirus Response Act (FFCRA, Public Law 116-127), signed into law March 18, 2020
• Coronavirus Aid, Relief, and Economic Security Act (CARES, Public Law 116-136), signed into law March 27, 2020
• Continuing Appropriations Act, 2021 and Other Extensions Act (CR, Public Law 116-159), signed into law October 1, 2020
• Consolidated Appropriations Act, 2021 (CAA, Public Law 116-260), signed into law December 27, 2020
• American Rescue Plan Act of 2021 (ARPA, Public Law 117-2), signed into law March 11, 2021
As part of our mission to perform independent oversight, we are providing transparency by detailing USDA’s pandemic response funding, to include its enacted appropriations, budgeted allocations, obligations, and outlays (expenditures).
